From Teunis G. Bergen's Register of the Early Settlers of Kings County, Long Island New York, p.323:5

VANDERVEER, CORNELIS JANSE (from the ferry), the common ancestor of the family, emigrated in 1659 from Alkmaar in North Holland; m. Tryntje Gillis de Mandeville. Bought Feb. 24, 1678-9, of Jan Janse Fyn for 2600 gl. a farm in Flh lying S. of the purchaser's farm, as per p. 57 of Lib. AA of Flh rec., from which it is evident that he was a resident of Flh at this date. The purchaser's farm referred to in the above description was probably a tract of 26 morgens in Flh, patented Mar. 12, 1661, by Gov. Stuyvesant to "Cornelis Janse," lying on the N. side of the land of Jan Snediker. His name appears as a mag. of Flh in 1678 and '80, and on the patent of said town of 1685. Issue:--Cornelis Junr; Neeltje Cornelise, m. Daniel Polhemus; Dominicus Cornelise, bp. Nov. 16, 1679, in Flds; Jan Cornelise; (sup.) Jacobus Cornelise; Micheal Cornelise; Maria Cornelise, bp. July 30, 1682, in Flh; Hendrikje Cornelise, bp. May 17, 1684, (sup.) m. Johannes Wyckoff; Jakoba Cornelise, bp. Apl. 29, 1686, in Brn, (sup.) m. John Cowenhoven of N. J.; and Pieter Cornelise. Signed his name "Cornelis Janse Vande Veer."

Lubbert Janse BUYS was born before 2 Feb 1656. He was baptized on 2 Feb 1656 in Reformed Dutch Church, Brooklyn, New Holland. (2050)(2051) The sponsors for the baptism were Jan Jansen Damen (Lubbert's great uncle) and Pietertje de Ruyter. He died in Nov 1663.(2052) (2053) He was accidentally killed by Cornelis Jansen Vanderveer who was subsequently forgiven by the Buys and Lubberts families, having petitioned for a pardon on November 29, 1663. Parents: Jan Cornelis BUYS and Eybetje Lubbertse VAN BLARICUM .

Jan Vander Veer      1   1   2   -   -

Jan purchased one half of a corn mill, half of the "dwelling house and the ground thereto belonging" from his brother in law, Daniel Polhemus. The balance of the property was purchased on 19 January 1696 and was described as being located on Fresh Kill. This became known as Vanderveer's Mill, located on Long Island. Further property was deeded to Jan on 5 May 1704 by his brothers and sisters. On the same date, Jan deeded to his brother Dominicus a corn mill with dwelling house and barn, locate on Fresh Kill. Jan was Town Supervisor in Flatbush from 1708-1714. During this time the document supplied to his brother Dominicus to collect monies from their Uncle Jacob Dominicus in the Netherlands was executed. He died 23 November 1732 and Femmetje died 27 December 1752, both in Flatbush. On 29 November 1732, his children signed a deed and power of attorney thereby settling his estate.

From Teunis G. Bergen, Register of the Early Settlers of Kings County, Long Island New York, p.324:5

Jan (Cornelise) of Flh, m. Jan. 6, 1695, Femmetje dau. of Michael Hansen Bergen. Took the oath of allegiance in Flh in 1687, of which town he was supervisor from 1708 to 1714. Jan. 1, 1696, he bought of Daniel Polhemius the one half of a corn-mill with its appurtenances, with the one half of the dwelling-house and of the ground thereto belonging, for 4000 gl., as per p. 221 of Lib. A of Flh rec. Jan. 19, 1698, he bought of D. Polhemius the remaining one half of the corn-mill with the ground thereto belonging, as granted by the town, located on the "Varse Kil" (Fresh Kil), as per p. 233 of said Lib. A. This is clearly the mill in N. L. at present known as Vanderveer's mill. Issue:--Katryna, bp. Mar. 29, 1696, in Brn; Femmetje, m. Jacob Sebring; and Jan of Keuter's Hoek, Flh, b. July 7, 1706, m. Cornelia dau. of Abm Lott. Signed his name "Jan Van Der Veer."

Abstracts of Wills Vol V 1754-1760, New York, page 219-220:

Page 473.--In the name of God, Amen. I, ISAAC REMSEN, of Brookland, in Kings County, yeoman, being sick and weak. All debts to be fully and truly paid. I leave to my wife Hendrycke 30 yearly during her life, Also a room in the house where I now live, "if she has a minde to ye same." I leave to my sons Jacob and Joris all the lands on the south east side of the highway leading to New York ferry, Also 3 acres of woodland lying between the woodland of Jeremias Remsen and the woodland of Jacob Duryee, Also 5 acres of woodland lying between the woodland of Jeronimus Rapalye and Rem Martsen, Also a half lot of meadow lying at the New Lots in the limits of Flatbush, Also a piece of meadow of 7 acres lying in Bushwick, adjoining the land of (???) Claes, And they are to pay  $\text{œ}1,200$ , viz., to the children of my sons  $\text{œ}100$  a year till paid. I leave to my son, Rem Remsen, all the land, meadow, and swamp on the north west side of the way, being the place I now live upon, Also the east end of my dwelling house and 1/2 of my barn, and he is to pay  $\text{œ}300$ . I leave to my son, Joris Remsen, the west end of my dwelling house and 1/2 of my barn. I leave to my sons, Isaac Remsen and John Remsen, all the land on which they now live at Oyster Bay, in Queens County. Isaac is to have all the south part and John the north part, and they are to pay (with what they have paid)  $\text{œ}1,030$  in 6 annual payments, "And my son Isaac is to pay  $\text{œ}40$  more than John, by reason of the buildings he possesses." I leave to my daughter Hendrycke  $\text{œ}70$  for an outset such as her sisters have had. Peter was taken hostage by the British when they were escaping from the Battle of Princeton. He was forced to march with them down river to show the British how to get to New Brunswick. He died a month or so later from pneumonia. There is a historical sign in front of the Campbell Farm that gives a brief account of the event.

Ann Van Doren's mother fed Washington's army when he maneuvered to Morristown after the Battle of Princeton. Ann must have been a child assisting her mother while Washington was taking nourishment. The D.A.R. have a plaque commemorating the event on Canal Road, Griggstown, NJ.

"VAN MATER, Daniel, Freehold, Monmouth Co., N.J. Joined Army when they came to N.J. in 1776 and gave every assistance. Furnished transport for Hessians from South Amboy to Trenton and Burlington. Also took Rebel Captain Tunis VANDEVERE, with some privates, disarmed and brought them into British lines. On the defeat at Trenton, withdrew hurriedly and went to N.Y., where he continued with Army until the evacuation. Memorial 22 July 1784 London. Claim: Horses and two negroes taken by Army; Indian corn supplied to Army at Princeton. Examination Apr. 1789. Henry VAN MATER says that in 1776 the two horses claimed were property of claimant's son-in-law Benjamin VAN MATER who never came within British lines. The negroes claimed were owned by claimant's father-in-law Roleff COVENHOVEN who (in his 80s) remained in his house during war. COVENHOVEN made a gift of the slaves to his son-in-law MAY 1783. Claimant, his brother, died in London in 1786 testate and examinant is one of his executors. (A013/9/397-407)."

What this Loyalist claim shows is that a person named Tunis VANDEVER (VANDERVEER) possibly was a Captain in the American Rebel (Patriot) troops. I suspect that this man is a candidate for the man mentioned in VAN MATER's Loyalist Claim. Tunis VANDERVEER son of Tunis and Altjie (SCHENCK) VANDERVEER of Freehold, Monmouth Co., NJ., and the date of birth that I have for him is 19 APR 1739. However, it might have been this man's son, Tunis, who mentioned the arrest by VAN MATER in his Rev War Pension application.

On "Explorer: The West Virginia History Database, Jefferson County Module" CD-Rom, there was an article entitled "Excavations on High Street: The Archaeology of an Historic Neighborhood in Shepherdstown, West Virginia" by Charles A. Hulse. This study was submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development in Charleston, WV May 15, 1995 in conjunction with excavations done prior to construction of a new science building on the Shepherd College Campus in Shepherdstown, WV. The study examined four historic residential lots containing remnants of houses built between 1770 and 1855. One of the lots, (Lot 58), involved JACOB VANDEVEER as owner of the property. Jefferson County was part of Berkeley County until 1802. Both were once part of Frederick county, Virginia. Shepherdstown's original name was Mecklenburg.

As known residents, other owners of the property are likewise elusive. Jacob Vandever listed as out-of-state address as Bedminster Township, Somerset County, New Jersey, in 1771, suggesting he was an absentee landlord at that time. His granddaughter, Femetje, and her husband, Clarkson Freeman, listed Mercer County, Kentucky, as their residence in the 1802 sale to Adam Myers, (Deed Book 1, p. 191, Jefferson Co.) The Vandever family also had large land holdings in Berkeley County in the late 18th century, but actual residence for family members are purely conjectural. The will of Jacob Vandever dated Oct. 2, 1772, (Will Book 1, p. 14, Frederick Co.), states: 1) "to grandson Jacob, son of my son Joseph deceased, the home and lot in Virginia in Mecklenburg which bought of Thomas Thornburg" and 2) "to granddaughter Femetje land bought of Chapline joining Jacobs."

Guisbert Sutphen lived on a farm lying half a mile north of the Larger Cross Roads, which is now owned and occupied by his great-grandson, Amos Sutphen. With his wife, Ariontje Van Pelt, he had entered the township in 1743, travelling with their children and household goods in an ox-cart from Monmouth county, where his father, also named Guisbert, had settled early in the century. When it was decided to build Bedminster church, differences of opinion arose as to the location. Both Sutphen and Van der Veer offered liberal inducements to have the building placed at points of their selection. Mr. Sutphen's choice was for the vicinity of the Larger Cross Roads, but eventually Mr. Van der Veer's views prevailed, and the new structure was erected on the site of the present edifice below the village of the Lesser Cross Roads, or Bedminster. The first minute of the new congregation was made by Mr. Hardenbergh in the Raritan church books on Christmas, 1758.... It is probable that the church was erected in that or the following year. Two acres of land were donated by Jacobus Van der Veer, who also furnished fifty pounds sterling and one-third of all the oak timber. The same amount of money, together with one-half of the oak necessary for the frame, was the gift of Guisbert Sutphen.(130)
